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**TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Authorized Distributors/Stockist or agents should furnish Photo copy of their Distributorship or Stockist or Agencies Certificate duly attested by a Gazzeted Officer or Notary and should produce Original Certificate at the time of opening the tender, if demanded.
2. Tenders should be submitted in the prescribed form only which can be obtained from the office of Directorate of Hospital & Medical Education, Mizoram, Aizawl on working days.
3. The cover of the tenders should be super scribed as **"Rate Contract of essential Drugs for mental illness under National Mental Health Programme, for a period of one year"** addressed to Director, Hospital & Medical Education, Government of Mizoram, Aizawl and should clearly indicate full postal address of the tenderer.
4. Non-tribal tenderer should affix a Non- Judicial Court Fee Stamp worth at least Rs.7.50/- and should furnish Original copy of valid GST Certificate.
5. The tribal tenderer should furnish attested copy of Tribal Certificate and Original copies should be produced at the time of opening, if demanded.
6. Tenders should be accompanied with the Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 16,000/- in case of Non-Tribal, and Rs 8,000/- in the case of Tribal Tenderers in the form of Demand Draft/Deposit at Call in original, from any Nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate duly pledged in favor of Director, Hospital & Medical Education , Mizoram, Aizawl.



7. Manufacturers submitting their tenders directly should attach photostat copies of their Manufacturing Licence, Drugs Licence, CIN (Corporate Identity Number) and other relevant permissions/licences required for such manufacturing, duly attested by a Gazette Officer or Notary. Original Certificates should be produced at the time of opening of the tenders/quotations, if demanded.
8. All tenders/quotations shall be accompanied by attested copy of valid Drugs Licence. And for all quoted items, Sample shall be submitted along with Quotations.
9. The tenderer should submit Notorized Photostat copy of valid and upto date GMP certificates with 3 years market standing alongwith the tender.
10. Tenderer should quote their rates in terms of Indian Rupees will be considered inclusive of **Goods and Services Tax (GST)**.
11. Tenderer should quote their rates for F.O.R destination i.e. Central Medical Store, Zembawk Aizawl.
12. All pages of the tender papers should be printed, signed, stamped and dated; hand written quotations shall not be entertained. Any page or pages not signed, stamped and dated will be marked violated clause at the time of opening of tender
13. If any tenderer violates or fails to fulfill any one of the clauses, his or her tender are liable to be rejected at the time of opening the tender/Purchase Board Meeting.
14. A successful firm should supply the materials within the period fixed by the Department/Authority. If the supply cannot be made within the stipulated period without any intimation, supply order will be treated as cancelled. The Department shall have the right to procure the materials from tenderer/firm approved by the Purchase Board as 2<sup>nd</sup> choice if any.
15. A successful firm should furnish Security Deposit of 5% of the value of the supply before issue of supply order in the form of Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit in any Nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate, as the case may be, duly pledged in favor of Director, Hospital & Medical Education, Government of Mizoram, Aizawl.
16. A successful firm should execute an appropriate Deeds of Agreement within 10 days from the date of issue of acceptance of their quoted rates failing which the firm will be treated as invalid tenderer.
17. The undersigned shall not be bound to accept the lowest rate.
18. Late/delayed tenders will not be entertained. Certificates other than those stated in the above clauses should not be attached. Any other/further clarifications in connection with submission of the tender may be made from the office of Director, Hospital & Medical Education, Mizoram during office hours on all working days.
19. In case of any legal disputes/litigations arising out of this Tender Notice or its terms, the Courts of Law at Aizawl only shall have jurisdiction to adjudicate the same.
20. All payments will be made only after the materials are received in full and in good condition duly approved/accepted by Vigilance Committee. Part payment will not be entertained.
