NOTIFICATION

Dated Aizawl, the 9th July, 2024

No.A.12032/1/2022-MPSC(DR): In supersession of the Guidelines for Conduct of examination for direct recruitment to services/posts falling under the purview of the Mizoram Subordinate Service Selection Board issued vide OM No.A.12011/1/2019-P&AR(GSW), dated 25.10.2019 and the syllabus for Group 'B' Non-Gazetted examinations under various Departments previously approved by the Government, the Mizoram Public Service Commission hereby prescribed the under mentioned syllabuses – one for General Competitive Examinations and the other for Technical Competitive Examinations – for recruitment to Group 'B' Non-Gazetted Posts under the Government of Mizoram :

SYLLABUSES FOR GROUP-'B' NON-GAZETTED POSTS

1. GENERAL COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION

General Competitive Examination shall be held when recruitment for a certain post does not have a specific guideline or when it does not require specific subject wise specification but can be written by any graduate from a recognised university.

The examination shall comprise of the following papers:

1) Paper –I : General English	: 100 Marks (3 hours)
2) Paper- II : General Knowledge & Reasoning (MCQ)	: 200 Marks (2 hours)
Total of Written Examination	: 300 Marks
3) Personal Interview	: 40 Marks
Total	: 340 Marks

DETAILED SYLLABUS:

1) General English	: 100 Marks (3 hours)
a) Précis Writing	: 10 marks
b) Letter Writing	: 15 marks
c) Comprehension of given passages	: 15 marks
d) Grammar: Parts of Speech	: 20 marks
e) Correct Usage and Vocabularies	: 20 marks
f) Formation of Sentence	: 20 marks

2) General Knowledge & Reasoning (MCQ) : 200 Marks (2 hours)

(i) General Knowledge (MCQ) : 100 marks

- (a) Current events of state, national and international importance : 12 marks
- (b) History of India and Indian National Movement : 12 marks
- (c) Indian and World Geography - Physical, Social, Economic Geography of India and the World : 12 marks
- (d) Indian Polity and Governance - Constitution, Political System, Public Policy, Duties & Rights Issues : 12 marks
- (e) Economic and Social Development, Sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social Sector initiatives, and other related issues : 12 marks
- (f) General issues on Environmental Ecology, Bio-diversity and Climate : 12 marks
- (g) General Science : 12 marks

The topics listed above shall cover the State of Mizoram wherever applicable.

- (h) General awareness on Mizo culture, its heritage and society : 16 marks

(ii) Simple Arithmetic (MCQ) : 60 marks

(iii) General Intelligences & Reasoning (MCQ) : 40 marks

2. TECHNICAL COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION

Technical Competitive Examinations shall be held when the relevant Recruitment Rules/Service Rules do not specify the mode on how an examination shall be conducted but invites an application from such persons who possess either a Graduate Degree or Post Graduation Degree or Diploma or any other lower qualifications on a Specific subject from a recognised university as specified in the relevant Recruitment/ Service/ Examination Rules/ Regulation.

The examination shall comprise of the following papers:

- 1) Paper – I : General English : 100 Marks (3 hours)
- 2) Paper – II : General Knowledge (MCQ) : 100 Marks (2 hours)
- 3) Paper – III : Technical Subject (MCQ) : 200 Marks (2 hours)
- 4) Paper – IV : Technical Subject (MCQ) : 200 Marks (2 hours)
- Total of Written Examination : 600 Marks
- 5) Personal Interview : 80 Marks
- Total : 680 Marks**

DETAILED SYLLABUS:

1) General English: 100 Marks (3 hours)

The detailed syllabus in General English paper shall be similar to that of the General Competitive Examinations.

2) General Knowledge (MCQ): 100 Marks (2 hours)

- (a) Current events of state, national and international importance : 12 marks
- (b) History of India and Indian National Movement : 12 marks
- (c) Indian and World Geography - Physical, Social, Economic Geography of India and the World : 12 marks
- (d) Indian Polity and Governance - Constitution, Political System, Public Policy, Duties & Rights Issues : 12 marks
- (e) Economic and Social Development, Sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social Sector initiatives, and other related issues : 12 marks
- (f) General issues on Environmental Ecology, Bio-diversity and Climate : 12 marks
- (g) General Science : 12 marks

The topics listed above shall cover the State of Mizoram wherever applicable.

- (h) General awareness on Mizo culture, its heritage and society : 16 marks

3) Technical Subject Paper-I (MCQ) : 200 Marks (2 hours)

4) Technical Subject Paper-II (MCQ) : 200 Marks (2 hours)

The syllabus of technical papers and the standard shall be based on the Recruitment / Service / Examination Rules / Regulations of the said posts. If there is no separate prescribed syllabus, the concerned department shall prepare and notify the syllabus in consultation with the Commission.

Consequently, these syllabuses shall be inserted in the Schedule-I of the Mizoram Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examinations) Guidelines, 2023 in conformity with Guideline No 14(2) of the same.
