## MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION OF MIZORAM INSTITUTE OF MEDICAL EDUCATION AND RESEARCH SOCIETY

- I. The Name of the society shall be "Mizoram Institute of Medical Education and Research Society, Falkawn, Mizoram".
- 1) The Registered office of the society shall be at Falkawn, Aizawl district, Mizoram.
  - 2) The society shall come into existence from the date of its registration with the Registrar of Societies, Mizoram.

## III. The objectives of the Institute shall be:

- To manage the day to day functioning of the Mizoram Institute of Medical Education and Research, its attached hospitals and other association health care facilities as per the directives of the State Government of Mizoram.
- 2. To provide primary, secondary and tertiary health care services to the public.
- 3. To provide advance and specialized medical facilities in selected specialties.
- 4. To serve as a regional referral service center for comprehensive health care;
- 5. To provide management consultancy in preventing, diagnostic, curative, and rehabilitative services for the entire State of Mizoram;
- 6. To provide and impact practical and on the job training including refresher courses in selected specialties to Medical and Para- Medical personnel sponsored by the State Government.
- 7. To conduct under graduate medical education course and training as per the guidelines of Medical Council of India for the candidates selected and/or sponsored by the State Government.
- 8. To conduct post graduate Medical Education course and training in subject approved by the Medical Council of India for candidates selected and/or sponsored by the State Government.

- 9. To develop and provide education, training and research facilities of the highest order for various type of Para Medical, Nursing, Dental, Supportive and Auxiliary staff at all levels;
- 10.To assist the State Government in regard to planning, establishing, managing and assessing the health and family welfare and medical education programs and other related activities;
- 11.To conduct research, especially in operational, applied and other studies as related to health sciences and manpower development;
- 12. To impose and recover fees and charges for services rendered;
- 13.To receive grants from the Government and gifts, donations benefactions, loans and subscription whether in case or securities or any property either movable or immovable in furtherance of the State Government.
- 14.To hold examinations and other academic distinctions and titles as may be laid down in accordance with the relevant Bye Laws;
- 15.To create required number of posts with prior approval of the State Government.
- 16.To appoint staff to fill up various posts with prior approval of the State Government through various committees prescribed under Service Bye-Laws;
- 17.To acquire and hold any movable or immovable property required in furtherance of the objectives of the institution with the approval of the State Government;
- 18.To sell, lease, exchange or otherwise transfer any property of the Institute with prior approval of the State Government;
- 19.To invest and deal with the funds and money of the Institute or entrust to it in such manner as may, from time to time, be determined by the Governing Council;
- 20.To do all such other lawful acts-as are conductive or incidental to the attainment of the above objectives.
