**RUALBANLO (TEMPORARY/PERMANENT) TE TAN REMCHANG ZAWK
DCH/DCHC/CCC/CCCC/DCCC INKAIHHRUAINA:**

1. Mahni a inenkawl thei lo tan awmpui neih phal a ni.
2. **DCH ah leh District tina CCC pakhat tal ah Wheel-chair a luh theihna ward ruahman tur a ni.**
3. Heng ward-a inthiarna te hi wheel chair hmang tan a hman theih tur a siam rem tur a ni. Ward pakhat tan inthiarna pakhat chauh a awm a nih chuan a awm chhun chu mitin tan a hman theih tura (wheelchair hmang tiamin) siam rem tur a ni ang.
4. Heng Covid-19 vei enkawlna hmuna test kalpui dan/damlo enkawl dan/ei in sem dan etc. chu rualbanlo te dinhmun hre rengin, a tul anga siam rem tur a ni ang.
5. Mahni a insaseng thei lo an awm thin avangin, an kawr thlak chung etc. a privacy an neih theihna turin an hman tur portable screen/parda chu ward ah kawl tur a ni ang.

ENGLISH VERSION:

GUIDELINES FOR ACCESSIBLE DCH/DCHC/CCC/CCCC/DCCC FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PERMANENT/ TEMPORARY)

1. Provision for the company of a care-taker where cases demand may be made available. In case the PwD is relatively independent as in the case of many blind PwDs, deaf/mute etc. such a provision may not be necessary.
2. **Wheel-chair accessible covid wards and toilets maybe made available at DCH and at least in one designated CCC in all districts in Mizoram.**
3. Even if there is only one toilet for the ward, the existing one may be converted to a universal design which is user friendly to differently abled persons.
4. The logistical services at the centres such as testing facilities, medical monitoring/treatment, nursing care, serving of meal etc. should be sensitive to the needs of the differently abled persons.
5. There should be provision of privacy in the form of portable screen/curtain etc. when the differently abled persons need to change clothes.
