## 1. Introduction

The Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) implements Health Insurance schemes of the Govt. of Mizoram including AB-PMJAY within the state. It also screens all Medical Reimbursement bills of Government Servants and their dependants. The beneficiaries in these schemes totals to over 3 lakh families. Recent analysis shows that claims related to Oncology had topped the charts in the past few years. The objective of this tender is to procure quality drugs and equipment from a reliable supplier at low price for use within the state of Mizoram.

### 3. Eligibility and Qualification Criteria for Bidders

- 3.1 Authorized Distributors/Stockist or agents should furnish Photo copy of their Distributorship or Stockist or Agencies Certificate duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or Notary and should produce Original Certificate at the time of opening the tender, if demanded.
- 3.2 Non-tribal tenderer should affix a Non- Judicial Court Fee Stamp worth at least ₹7.50/- and should furnish attested copy of GST registration certificate by the concerned authority.
- 3.3 The tribal tenderer should furnish attested copy of Tribal Certificate and GST Registration issued by the competent authority. Original copies should be produced at the time of opening, if demanded.
- 3.4 Manufacturers submitting their tenders directly should attach photostat copies of their Manufacturing Licence, Drugs Licence, CIN (Corporate Identity Number) and other relevant permissions/licences required for such manufacturing, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or Notary. Original Certificates should be produced at the time of opening of the tenders/quotations, if demanded.
- 3.5 All tenders/quotations shall be accompanied by attested copy of valid General Drugs Licence.
- 3.6 The tenderer should submit attested/notarized copy of upto date ISO/GMP Certificate alongwith tender documents.
- 3.7 If any Bidder violates or fails to fulfill any one of the above mentioned requirements, his or her tender may be liable to be rejected at the time of opening of the tender.

### 4. Clarifications and Pre-Bid Meeting

- 4.1 If a Bidder requires any clarification on the Tender Document, it may notify the SHA in writing at the email ([mz.sha.etender@gmail.com](mailto:mz.sha.etender@gmail.com)), provided that all queries or clarification requests should be received on or before the due date and time mentioned in the Bid Data Sheet.
- 4.2 The responses to such queries shall be published on the Health & Family Welfare, Government of Mizoram website (<https://health.mizoram.gov.in/>)/ email ([mz.sha.etender@gmail.com](mailto:mz.sha.etender@gmail.com)) (as appropriate) within the time frame indicated in the Bid Data Sheet.
- 4.3 The SHA may also on its own motion, if deemed necessary, issue interpretations and clarifications to all Bidders. All clarifications and interpretations issued by the SHA shall be deemed to be part of the Tender Documents. Verbal clarifications and information given by SHA/NHA or its employees or representatives shall not in any way or manner be binding on the SHA. These will be put up on the SHA's/Schemes/E-tender website: <https://health.mizoram.gov.in/>
- 4.4 The Pre-Bid meeting shall be held via Video Conference. The link or means of access to Video Conference will be uploaded at the portal <https://health.mizoram.gov.in/> or queries and information can be raised to [mz.sha.etender@gmail.com](mailto:mz.sha.etender@gmail.com).

## 5. Amendments to the Tender Document

- 5.1 Up until the date that is specified in the Bid Data Sheet, the SHA may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a query raised or clarification requested by Bidder(s) at the Pre-Bid Meeting, amend the Tender Document by issuing an Addendum.
- 5.2 Any Addendum thus issued will be uploaded on the <https://health.mizoram.gov.in/>
- 5.3 Each Addendum shall be definitive and binding on the Bidders.
- 5.4 Any oral statement made by the SHA or its advisors regarding the Bidding Process, the Tender Document or the Scheme or on any other matter related to the Scheme, shall not be considered as amending the Tender Document.

## 6. Bid Security

Earnest Money amounting to ₹50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft in original from any Nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate duly pledged in favour of Chief Executive Officer, Mizoram State Health Care Society, Aizawl. The bidder must mail a scanned copy of the Receipt at [mz.sha.etender@gmail.com](mailto:mz.sha.etender@gmail.com)

## 7. Bid Submission

- 7.1 Tender has been called for in the generic names and Bidders should quote the rates for the generic products.
- 7.2 A Non-tribal bidder should affix a Non- Judicial Adhesive Stamp worth of at least ₹7.50/- only and should furnish photostat copy of valid sales Tax/VAT Registration certificate or document up to the latest year for which assessment has been made by the concerned authority, and duly attested by a Gazette Officer or Notary. Original Certificate should be produced at the time of opening of the tenders/quotations, if demanded.
- 7.3 Manufacturers/Marketers/Distributors submitting their bids should attach an original scan copies of their Manufacturing/Marketing/Distributor License, Drugs License, CIN (Corporate Identity Number) and other relevant permissions/licenses required for such manufacturing/marketing, duly attested by a Gazette Officer or Notary. Original Certificates should be produced at the time of opening of the bids/quotations, if demanded.
- 7.4 All bids/quotations shall be accompanied by original scan copy of valid Drugs License of the Bidder/Manufacturer/Marketeers/Distributor for dealing with the drugs covered under Drugs & Cosmetics Act.
- 7.5 The Bidder should submit Notorized Photostat copy of valid and up to date GMP and CoPP Certificates.
- 7.6 Bidder should have experience & knowledge of modes of packing, distribution & transportation of such items under any weather conditions.
- 7.7 All pages of the tender papers should be printed, signed, stamped and dated; hand written quotation shall not be entertained. Any page or pages not signed, stamped and dated are liable to be rejected. Correction, if any, should be initialed, stamped and dated.

- 7.8 Bids must be submitted in the prescribed form (Appendix – II) only through email ([mz.sha.etender@gmail.com](mailto:mz.sha.etender@gmail.com)) where no other mode of submission is permitted. Documents above 20 Mb may utilize Google Drive and send on the above email with permissions configured. **Financial Bids may be encrypted and sent to the said email.** The Decryption code shall be provided by the Bidder at the time of Financial Bid Opening.
- 7.9 A Bidder should quote his/her rates in terms of Indian Rupees inclusive of all taxes and duties.
- 7.10 Bidder should quote their rates F.O.R destination – Civil Hospital, Aizawl and Mizoram State Cancer Institute (MSCI), Zembabawk, Aizawl, Mizoram.
- 7.11 **The quote on Anti-cancer drugs in Financial Bid (Appendix – II) should not exceed NPPA Revised MRP of Non-Scheduled Anti-Cancer medicine Dated 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2019.**
- 7.12 The Bid should be accompanied by Bid Application Cover Letter, Applicant details and Checklist as format provided in Qual-1, Qual-2 and Qual-3.
- 7.13 Belated/delayed tenders shall not be entertained in any case. Certificates other than those stated in the foregoing clauses shall be rejected straightaway. Any other/further clarifications in connection with submission of tender mentioned herein may be made from the office of the Chief Executive Officer, Mizoram State Health Care Society, Aizawl during office hours on all working days.

## 8. Opening of Bids

- 8.1 The SHA shall open the Qualifying Bids received on or before time specified in Bid Data Sheet as Bid Due Date at the date and time indicated in the Bid Data Sheet as per the time that is displayed from the server clock at the top of the e-tender Portal on the following address: State Health Agency, Dinthar, Aizawl, Mizoram
- 8.2 The Qualified Bidders will be informed of a date, time and place for the opening and evaluation of their Financial Bids.
- 8.3 The Financial Bids of only those Bidders who have passed the Qualification Criteria will be considered for evaluation on the intimated date. The Financial Bids will be opened online and in the presence of the representatives of Qualified Bidders.
- 8.4 Representatives of Bidders that are not declared as Qualified Bidders will not be permitted to attend the opening of Financial Bids The procedure for evaluation of the Financial Bids.
- 8.5 The Bidders may remain present at the time of opening of Financial Bids. However, the results of the Financial Bids of all Bidders shall be available on the e-Tender Portal immediately after the completion of opening process.
- 8.6 Bidders are advised that the qualification of Bidders and evaluation of the Bids will be entirely at the discretion of the SHA. Bidders will be deemed to have understood and agreed that no explanation or justification on any aspect of the Selection process or selection will be given.

## 9. Evaluation of Bids and Selection of Successful Bidder

### 9.1 Evaluation of the Qualification Bid



The Qualification Bids will first be evaluated for responsiveness to the Tender Documents and evidences for fulfilment of the qualification criteria based on the following parameters:

- a. The Bid is complete in all respects and in the prescribed formats.
- b. It contains no material alterations, conditions, deviations or omissions.
- c. All documents required as specified in the Tender Documents and submitted by the Bidder are appropriate and valid.
- d. All undertakings required under this Tender Document are in the prescribed format and unconditional.
- e. Based on the review of documents the SHA comes to the conclusion, beyond any reasonable doubt, that the Bidder fulfils the minimum qualification criteria.
- f. The application is unconditional in all respects.

## **9.2 Evaluation of Financial Bids**

Upon opening of the Financial Bids of the Eligible Bidders, they will first be evaluated for responsiveness to the Tender Documents. If: (i) any Financial Bid is not complete in all respects; or (ii) any Financial Bid is not duly signed by the authorized representative of the Bidder; or (iii) any Financial Bid is not in the prescribed formats; and (iv) any Financial Bid contains material alterations, conditions, deviations or omissions, then such Financial Bid shall be deemed to be substantially non-responsive. Such Financial Bid that is deemed to be substantially non-responsive shall be rejected.

## **9.3 Selection of the Successful Bidder**

In selecting the Successful Bidder, the objectives of the SHA is to select Bidder that:

- a. is an Eligible Bidder;
- b. has submitted a Financial Bid complete in all respects; and has quoted the:
  - a) Lowest Gross Financial Cost (L-1)
    - i) The Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) reserves the right to select the bidder with the lowest quote for each individual drug listed in clause 2 of the tender document
    - ii) It is desired that the same manufacturer/company is selected for the listed chemotherapy injectables having multiple dosages. The lowest average quoted amount for each chemotherapy injectables having multiple dosages will be considered, however, manufacturers/marketers/distributors quoting lower rates for the most commonly used dosages will be preferred.
    - iii) In case two or more bidders have the same lowest composite cost (rounded off to two decimal points), the MSHCS shall call for second stage bidding/reverse bidding on the same day amongst the bidders giving the same lowest cost and make selections accordingly.

- 9.4 The Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) shall not be bound to accept the lowest rate or any of the bids even if valid, and reserves the right to

accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof. The Society may give preference to supplier/firms of reputed brand/company and having good performance record.

## 10. Terms of Contract

- 10.1 It shall be the responsibility of the successful Bidder for any shortages/damage at the time of receipt by the Hospital concerned.
- 10.2 The successful Bidder shall supply the product to reach the consignee/Hospital within 60 days from the date of manufacture of the drugs. In case the product is received after 90 days from the date of manufacture and the product is not consumed before its expiry date, the successful Bidder shall be permitted to replace the expired quantity with fresh stock of longer shelf life otherwise the expired product will be returned to the successful Bidder and the value equal to the cost of expired quantity will be recovered.
- 10.3 Once the rate is accepted by Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) and communicated to the successful Bidder, the same shall remain valid throughout the life of the agreement as may be executed in due course with the approved Bidder and no further price escalation will be allowed during such validity period which shall normally be a period of 12 months from the date of execution of the agreement and may be extended, if mutually agreed upon by both the parties i.e. the Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) and the concerned Bidder.
- 10.4 A successful Bidder whose tender has been accepted will have to execute an appropriate Deed of Agreement within 15 (fifteen) days from the date Notice of Award (NOA), failing which their Bid will be treated as invalid.
- 10.5 A successful Bidder will have to supply the materials tendered for, within the period of 15 days from the date of purchase order and/or any specified in the agreement. If the supply cannot be made within the stipulated period without any valid and justifiable reasons with prior intimation, the society shall be at liberty to procure the materials from the next lowest Bidder and the differences in prices, if any, will be realized from the Security Deposit of the successful and approved Bidder without assigning any reason thereof.
- 10.6 The Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) will not take responsibility for supplying Road Permits.
- 10.7 Payments will be made only after the materials are received in full and in good condition to be certified by the Vigilance Committee of the Directorate and after completion of the installation satisfactorily, whatever it is required so. There shall not be any advance payment and no such request shall be entertained.
- 10.8 In case of failure to supply within stipulated time without any intimation by the supplier, the Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) has the right to cancel the supply order. The Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) may purchase the items from other sources from the fund sanctioned against these items and such purchase would not entail any legal implication on the part of the society.
- 10.9 No price escalation will be permissible and rates of items over and above approved rates will not be accepted.
- 10.10 The supplied items should conform to the quality standards as prescribed for each item. In case of any item found to be 'not of standard quality', the

firm shall be considered for blacklisting and the supplier shall retrieve all batches of the product as it shall be deemed to be rejected goods.

The Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) will be at the liberty to arrange alternative procurement from any other source.

- 10.11 The quality of the items supplied shall be of WHO standards. The successful bidder shall take back the drugs which are not utilized by the Society within the shelf life period.
- 10.12 Any attempts for negotiation/campaign, direct or indirect, on the part of a tenderer with the authority to whom he has submitted the Tender or the authority who is competent finally to accept, shall render such Tender liable to be excluded from consideration, if proved.

## 11. Rights of MSHCS

The SHA reserves the right, in its sole discretion and without any liability to the Bidders, to:

- 11.1 Accept or reject any Bid or annul the Bidding Process or reject all Bids at any time prior to the award of the Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder(s);
- 11.2 accept the lowest Bid;
- 11.3 suspend and/or cancel the Bidding Process and/or amend and/or supplement the Bidding Process or modify the dates or other terms and conditions relating thereto;
- 11.4 consult with any Bidder in order to receive clarification or further information in relation to its Bid; and
- 11.5 independently verify, disqualify, reject and/or accept any and all submissions or other information and/or evidence submitted by or on behalf of any Bidder.

## 12. Event of Default

- 12.1 In the event of the samples of Drugs failing quality tests or found to be not 'intact' and complaints are received from the Hospitals, the Society is at liberty to make alternative purchase for which the purchase orders have been placed from any other Bidder who might have quoted higher rates at the risk and the cost of the successful Bidder and in such cases the Society will have every right to recover the cost and impose penalty.
- 12.2 If any tenderer violates or fails to fulfill any one of the clauses, his or her tender are liable to be rejected at the time of opening the tender by the *Technical Board* constituted by the Govt. of Mizoram

## 13. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

In case of any legal dispute/litigations arising out of this Tender Notice or its terms, the competent courts at State capital Aizawl shall have exclusive jurisdiction over all disputes arising under, pursuant to and/or in connection with the Bidding Process.

Nothing has been omitted which renders such information misleading and all documents accompanying such Qualification Bid are true copies of their respective originals.
2. We shall make available to the Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS)

any clarification that it may find necessary or require to supplement or authenticate our Qualification Bid.

3. We acknowledge the right of the Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) to reject our Qualification Bid or not to declare us as the Eligible Bidder, without assigning any reason or otherwise and we hereby waive, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable laws, our right to challenge the same on any account whatsoever.
4. We undertake that we satisfy the Qualification Criteria and meet all the requirements as specified in the Tender Documents.
5. We represent and warrant that:
  - a. We have examined the Tender Documents and have no reservations to the same, including all Addenda issued by the Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS).
  - b. We accept the terms of the Contract that will be signed and shall seek no material deviation from or otherwise seek to materially negotiate the terms of the Contract, if declared as the Successful Bidder.
  - c. The Mizoram State Health Care Society (MSHCS) is not obliged to return the Qualification Bid or any part thereof or any information provided along with the Qualification Bid, other than in accordance with provisions set out in the Tender Documents.
