A Gazette Officer or Notary, however, should duly attest Photostat copies. Original Certificate should be produced at the time of opening, if demanded.
- 2. Earnest Money should accompany tenders. 3% of bid amount in case of Non-Tribal and 2% of bid amount in case of Tribal Tenders in the form of Deposit at Call/ Bank Guarantee/ Fixed Deposit in original, from any Nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate duly pledged in favor of Mission Director, State Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl.
- 3. Tenders should be submitted in duplicate marked "Original" and "Duplicate" on the cover envelope.
