SHORT TENDER NOTICE

Sealed Short Tenders are hereby invited on behalf of the Chairman, Mizoram State Health Society from reputed and bonafide Manufacturers or Authorized Distributors, Stockists or Agents who have GST registration for **Rate Contract of Drugs, Reagents etc under NHM, Mizoram for a period of one year** which will be received by the Mission Director, NHM, Health & FW Department, Dinthar, Aizawl, Mizoram, on or before **23.02.2018 (Friday) upto 12:00 Noon** under the terms and conditions laid down below. Quotations are to be opened by Mission Director, NHM, Mizoram, Aizawl or his authorized representatives at **1 PM** on the same day. The Tenderers or their representative may also be present at the time of opening of the Tender, if desired.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Authorized Distributors/Stockist or agents should furnish Photo copy of their Distributorship or Stockist or Agencies Certificate duly attested by a Gazzeted Officer or Notary and should produce Original Certificate at the time of opening the tender, if demanded.
2. Tenders should be submitted in the prescribed form only which can be obtained from the office of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl on working days.
3. The cover of the tenders should be superscribed as ***"Tender for Rate Contract of Drugs, Reagents etc under NHM, Nizoram for a period of one year"*** addressed to Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl and should clearly indicate full postal address of the tenderer.
4. Non-tribal tenderer should affix a Non- Judicial Court Fee Stamp worth at least Rs.7.50/- and should furnish attested copy of GST registration certificate by the concerned authority.
5. The tribal tenderer should furnish attested copy of Tribal Certificate and GST Registration issued by the competent authority. Original copies should be produced at the time of opening, if demanded.
6. Tenders should be accompanied with the Earnest Money Deposit of 2% of the total value of the quoted items in the form of Demand Draft/Deposit at Call in original, from any Nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate duly pledged in favor of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl.
7. Manufacturers submitting their tenders directly should attach photostat copies of their Manufacturing Licence, Drugs Licence, CIN (Corporate Identity Number) and other relevant permissions/licences required for such manufacturing, duly attested by a Gazette Officer or Notary. Original Certificates should be produced at the time of opening of the tenders/quotations, if demanded.

8. All tenders/quotations shall be accompanied by attested copy of valid Drugs Licence.
9. The tenderer should submit attested/notarized copy of upto date ISO/GMP Certificate alongwith tender documents .
10. Tenderer should quote their rates in terms of Indian Rupees. Rate should be quoted inclusive of all taxes and duties and should be mentioned clearly in the quotation.
11. Tenderer should mention F.O.R Destination Central Medical Store, Zembawk and rates thereof.
12. Tenderer should submit samples/brochures/catalogues against the quoted items alongwith other documents.
13. Soft copy of tender documents shall be enclosed alongwith other documents.
14. All pages of the tender papers should be printed,signed,stamped and dated; hand written quotations shall not be entertained. Any page or pages not signed, stamped and dated will be marked violated clause at the time of opening of tender.
15. If any tenderer violates or fails to fulfill any one of the clauses, his or her tender are liable to be rejected at the time of opening the tender by Technical Committee and Purchase Committee Meeting.
16. A successful firm should supply the items within the period fixed by the society/Authority. If the supply cannot be made within the stipulated period without any intimation, supply order will be treated as cancelled. The society shall have the right to procure the items from other sources.
17. A successful firm should furnish Security Deposit of 5% of the value of the supply before issue of supply order in the form of Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit in any Nationalized Bank of India or Postal Saving Certificate, as the case may be, duly pledged in favor of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl.
18. A successful firm should execute an appropriate Deeds of Agreement within 14 days from the date of issue of acceptance of their quoted rates failing which the firm will be treated as invalid tenderer.
19. The undersigned shall not be bound to accept the lowest rate.
20. Late/delayed tenders will not be entertained. Certificates other than those stated in the above clauses should not be attached. Any other/further clarifications in connection with submission of the tender may be made from the office of Mission Director, National Health Mission, Mizoram, Aizawl during office hours on all working days.
21. In case of any legal disputes/litigations arising out of this Tender Notice or its terms, the Courts of Law at Aizawl only shall have jurisdiction to adjudicate the same.
22. All payments will be made only after the materials are received in full and in good condition duly approved/accepted by Vigilance Committee. Part payment will not be entertained.

23. Any attempts for negotiation/campaign, direct or indirect, on the part of a tender with the authority to whom he has submitted the Tender or the authority who is competent finally to accept, shall render such Tender liable to be excluded from consideration, if proved.
